Observing increased hay moving into the United States causing concern for welfare issues in Canada. Reminder to attend the BCRC webinar on July 29, 2021.

Wowk, Hale, Lyseng & Dubeau among others representing ABP and CCA attended receptions at the Calgary Stampede. An opportunity to discuss the situation with politicans to impress upon them the severity of the situation.

Lobbying for multi-year tax defferal.

Directors noticed extensive media coverage on the drought situation.

Many American States facing the same situation with limited feed supplies.

ABP communications to directors, delegates and media seemed to be working on all platforms.

It was noted that in some areas, feed is at the \$460/bale.

Feedlots expecting higher feed costs this fall, probably not short forage but short in other areas, such as barley and straw.

Mark Lyseng provided an update on how AFSC details of the program could look like.

A draft document of ABP, WSGA, ACFA and AGLA asks:

- -concern around the \$300/head and how that may affect feed prices.
- -continue to press around water development.
 -felt the asks were heading in the right direction.

Metabolic Risks – provide information for produces to balance feed and minerals.
