Province of Origin

Everyone who deducts and remits check-off dollars to Alberta Beef Producers is required to report the number of cattle for which the check-off has been deducted by province of origin. The province of origin is defined as the province of residence of the seller of the cattle.

Cattle purchased and transported outside of BC are subject to a BC Cattle Industry Development Fund (CIDC) Levy. This levy is deducted from the *seller* on the Ownership Identification Inc. (OII) Livestock Transportation Certificate during export inspections. Remitters are to retain copies of the OII Livestock Transportation Certificates to support their records.

Cattle that had the CIDC Levy applied upon exiting BC are eligible to have the Alberta Check-Off waived.
