## (a) U.S. Tariffs

The Board of Directors held a special meeting March 13, 2025 to discuss the priorities ABP feels should be put forward to the Government of Alberta. They are provided in package.

#### (b) Code of Conduct and Respectful Workplace

 The Board of Directors was provided with a copy of each and asked if anyone had any suggested changes, to advise before April 20, 2025, after which time they will be circulated to the Delegate body.
